Aggregate Competition

Annually, an aggregate competition is held in two grades "A" & "B". (Work entered in the Novice section is non-competitive. See below also.)

Work is entered monthly with a set subject and an open subject.

Club Night Competition Entries

On Club Night each member is allowed one entry which may consist of up to THREE images. The images can be shared amongst any of the categories mentioned above or they may all be entered in one category.

Any one image may be entered three times only i.e. once in open subject, once in the set subject and once in the End of Year competition.

ALL entries including prints and projected images (digital and/or slides) will be required **to be submitted by 12 noon on the Saturday 17 days before the Tuesday meeting - all entries close on the same day - a Saturday and at 12 noon.** Prints can be delivered to the Print Steward at the previous months Club Night i.e. images for March can be delivered at February's meeting.

PRINTS

Drop into **Photopro**, Suite 2/477 Ruthven Street, Toowoomba, **by 12 noon on the Saturday 17 days before the Tuesday meeting.** Please place the following information on the back of entries:

Name of Author
Title of Image
Grade A, B or Novice
Open or Set Subject
Size of print

Write on the top back left hand side of the print to indicate the TOP of the image. Use a white sticker if the matt is other than white.

All members are to ensure their work is packed in thin plastic, paper bags or cardboard container. If each pair of prints is interleaved with suitable paper and then placed in a plastic bag, adequate protection will be afforded.

PROJECTED IMAGES

Slides: Drop into **Photopro**, Suite 2/477 Ruthven Street Toowoomba **by 12 noon on the Saturday 17 days before the Tuesday meeting.** Please include the following information:

Name of Author
Title of Image
Grade A, B or Novice
Open or Set Subject

Digital files: Email to the Projected Images Steward **by 12 noon on the Saturday 17 days before the Tuesday meeting.** Members will be sent a reminder email each month from the Projected Images Steward and this will include details of the delivery of digital files. All entries will be acknowledged by the Projected Images Steward.

Projected images can be submitted on disk/memory sticks. These can be mailed or dropped to the Projected Images Steward **by prior arrangement.**

All digital files should be named in the following manner **and order:**

Grade (A B or N)_Subject (O or S)_Mono(if applicable)_Your name_Title of image

Example: For Mary Jones who is a B grader entering a set subject image titled 'Grape vine' the file name would be - **B_S_Mary Jones_Grape Vine.jpg**
