## Conditions of Entry

1. An official entry form, or photostat copy, must be completed by each entrant, with a maximum of four prints to be submitted by any entrant.
2. The judges select approximately fifty prints for display in the exhibition. Entrants are asked to interpret 'Olympic Values - Excellence, Respect, Friendship'. As the three acquired prints chosen from this fifty will be hung in commercial premises, the subject material should be positive in mood and nature, not personal and not consist of offensive material. Prints selected for exhibition will be displayed framed.
3. For all categories, other than the Young Photographer Awards, prints must be unmounted, either monochrome or colour. Prints must be strictly no larger than 16" x 12" (40.6cm x 30.5cm), and no smaller than 11.7" (29.7cm) on the long side. This is the actual paper size. Any prints not compliant with the sizes mentioned above will not be eligible for judging and will be disqualified from the competition.
4. The Young Photographer Award entries must be emailed to: [heritagephotographicawards@heritage.com.au](mailto:heritagephotographicawards@heritage.com.au). The maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels. Each image file should be in the RGB JPEG format and a maximum of 2Mb in file size allowing for minimum compression only. Further details refer to [www.heritage.com.au](http://www.heritage.com.au)
5. Prints previously submitted for these awards are not eligible.
6. Prints submitted must be the original work of the entrant. All images must have been exposed by the entrant, and all entrants are requested to ensure that the prints are processed for maximum permanence. Professionally processed and ink jet prints are permitted. Prints must be submitted in flat postage materials. No cylinders are permitted. Original packaging will not be returned to the entrant.
7. There is no obligation on the part of Heritage Bank to display all prints submitted in the exhibitions.
8. The entry fee is \$25 (inclusive of return postage and GST) per entrant for up to four prints, and this fee must accompany the entry form and prints. The entry fee is not refundable if the print is not selected for the exhibition. Cheques or money orders should be made out to Heritage Acquisitive Photographic Awards.
9. Entry into the Young Photographer Awards, ie for entrants between the ages of 7-17 years of age, is free.
10. Entries into the Young Photographer Awards are to be submitted electronically by emailing images to: [heritagephotographicawards@heritage.com.au](mailto:heritagephotographicawards@heritage.com.au)
11. Each print must be distinctly marked on the back with the photographer's name and address, as well as the title and purchase price to correspond with the entry form. It is suggested the entrant uses a chinagraph, soft pencil or small label.
12. Heritage Bank reserves the right to reproduce any print selected for acquisition for archival and catalogue purposes.
13. Exhibited prints not acquired by Heritage will be made available for sale at the purchase price nominated by the photographer. Payment of sales and acquisitions will be made by Heritage to the photographer within 30 days of the close of the Rosalie Gallery exhibition. The four prints acquired by Heritage and the Bruce Mackenzie Memorial Youth Award print will not be available for sale at the exhibitions. The 50 images selected for exhibition will also be able to be viewed on the Heritage Bank website.
14. Heritage reserves the right to exhibit at any place or reproduce by newspaper, book, television or internet without fee, any photograph(s) entered in the Competition. Due regard will be given to the preservation of the artistic integrity of the works. The signed entry form is evidence of photographer consent. Copyright at all times remains with the entrant.
15. The selection of acquired prints will be made by the Judging Panel and the judges' decision shall be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
16. All acquired prints will be purchased for the prize money as stated plus an Owen Camera House voucher regardless of the price shown by the entrant on this entry form.

The Heritage Acquisitive Photographic Awards are open to all professional and amateur photographers.

With the London Olympic Games taking place later in 2012, the Awards this year have taken their inspiration from the Olympic ideals.

To provide a focus and inspiration for entrants, this year's theme is the Olympic values of Excellence, Respect and Friendship.

All entries must reflect this theme in some way.



The topic is open to interpretation and is not limited to sporting photographs. Your photograph can include only one value, or all three of the values. The way you interpret the theme is limited only by your imagination and creativity.

A selection of fifty prints will be framed for exhibition at the University of Southern Queensland's Arts Gallery and the Rosalie Gallery, Goombungee, where the non-acquired prints exhibited will be available for sale.

### Awards

#### Acquisitive

Three prints will be purchased by Heritage Bank for \$1000 each and the artists responsible will also receive a Camera House voucher to the value of \$150.

#### Non Acquisitive

Three prints will be awarded **Special Commendations** and the artists responsible will receive \$500 each from Heritage Bank and a Camera House voucher to the value of \$100.

Three prints will be awarded **Commendations** and the artists responsible will receive \$250 each from Heritage Bank and a Camera House voucher to the value of \$75.

Three prints will be awarded **Encouragement Awards** and the artists responsible will receive \$100 each from Heritage Bank and a Camera House voucher to the value of \$50.

#### CEO's Choice Award

One print will be personally selected by the Chief Executive Officer of Heritage Bank, to be purchased for \$500 and the artist responsible will also receive a Camera House voucher to the value of \$100.

#### Bruce Mackenzie Memorial Youth Award

This award is made each year in honour of the late Mr Bruce Mackenzie who was a photographer with The Chronicle before his death in 1991. In keeping with Mr Mackenzie's support for young photographers, all entrants under the age of 25 years, at the official closing date, are eligible for the Bruce Mackenzie Memorial Youth Award. Such entrants should indicate their eligibility for this Award on the entry form.

The Chronicle will purchase the winning print for \$1000 and the artist responsible will also receive \$1000 from the Mackenzie family in addition to an individual trophy from The Chronicle.

#### Young Photographer Award (Free entry)

- Group 1, 14-17 years of age
- Group 2, 10-13 years of age
- Group 3, 7-9 years of age.

Open to all school students, the Heritage Acquisitive Photographic Awards Young Photographer Award is an exciting opportunity for students to enter a prestigious national competition and have the opportunity to see their work exhibited under gallery conditions. All entrants in these groups are eligible for consideration for the Bruce Mackenzie Memorial Youth Award.

The winners from each group of the Young Photographer Award will receive an Owen Camera House voucher to the value of \$100, a certificate of merit and have their print displayed in the Exhibition.

### Judging

A panel of three judges will assess the prints submitted for the Heritage Acquisitive Photographic Awards, except the CEO's Choice Award.

The judges will nominate approximately fifty prints which will comprise the 2012 Heritage Acquisitive Photographic Awards Exhibition.
